Project Case Study: Monaghan County Council Local Authority Action Plan

BUILDING POSITIVE RELATIONS (€1,321,117.01):

This part of the plan will support six initiatives including: an intergenerational programme, cross-community engagement and cultural awareness programmes and a small grants programme that will include a project utilising a model of story telling to acknowledge the different memories and perspectives of politically motivated exprisoners and their families.

<u>Key Output:</u> Local Action Plans that result in meaningful, purposeful and sustained contact between persons from different communities: 1

SHARED SPACES AND SERVICES (€1,078,906.06):

This part of the plan will develop the shared aspects of existing neighbourhoods, public spaces and buildings. Projects include the development of a playpark in Rossmore Park, the development of arts studios in Clones Town and a small grants programme to include a multi-use games area in Doohamlet; renovations to the Orange Hall in Glaslough; and renovations to the Protestant Hall in Mullapike.

<u>Key Output</u>: Local initiatives that facilitate the sustained usage on a shared basis of public areas/buildings: 1

CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE (€6,38,544.89):

This part of the plan will facilitate four projects including: a youth resilience project; a cross-community engagement programme; a peace building through sport project; and an innovative 'Lego Mindstorm' project that will involve five primary and six secondary schools.

<u>Key Output</u>: Number of participants aged 0-24 completing approved programmes that develop their soft skills and a respect for diversity: 839.
